

The meeting was called to order by Lynn W. at 10:01 A.M. on Saturday, January 9, 2021. It opened with all reciting the Serenity Prayer. Bridging the Gap had no report. Archives chair Kara asked for names of members with 30+ years of sobriety to be interviewed for our archival committee to preserve their stories of triumph over alcohol. Hotline reported that the Area chair will be calling a meeting to determine which phone number will be utilized.

Intergroup Liaison Chris C. informed the group that Founders' Day will be celebrated on March 20, 2021. Groups are asked to determine if they would participate in panel presentations, and GSR' s will ask their groups if they are interested in such a program. DCM Lynn asked if the group would like to participate in virtual meetings. It was decided after discussion to continue to hold district meetings in person.

Under New Business, Lynn asked the group when to hold a GSR Orientation. It was decided that Orientation will be held on January 30, 2021 with a location to be decided. The group was asked if the meetings of the District would continue to be held on the second Saturday of each month at 10:00 A.M. It was agreed that District 11 would meet on the second Saturday of each month at 10:00 A.M. at the Westend.

The next meeting for District 11 will be Saturday, February 12, 2021 at 10:00 A.M.
